Founded in 2000, the mission of Moriah is to assemble a worldwide network (faculty) of the "five-fold ministry" (Ephesians 4:12) in order to educate (Latin "draw out") and "to prepare God's people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up" (NIV). A virtual college whose campus is the world, Moriah delivers degreed programs and church ministry certifications to individual students (Online World Campus) and to structured groups of students (Network Lecture Sites) using audio/video presentations and/or guest teachers.

Thoroughly Christian in scope and non-traditional in sequence, we are the church training the church to be the church! Dedicated to theological excellence, every instructor teaches only in his/her area of passion and life message. As such, MORIAH brings outstanding biblical *instruction* and more importantly, spiritual *impartation* from teacher to student! DEGREES OFFERED

All degrees are earned by accumulation of credit hours — whether earned, transferred, or applied as a result of ministerial/life experience. The following degrees are available to MORIAH students:

- Associate of Theology (A.Th.) 60 Semester Credit Hours
- Bachelor of Theology (B.Th.) 126 Semester Credit Hours

- Doctor of Christian Studies (D.C.S.) 261 Semester Credit Hours
- Doctor of Ministry (D.Min.) 306 Semester Credit Hours

TUITION & FEES

The Moriah tuition fee is \$45.00 per credit hour. (A typical three hour credit course is \$135.00.) For the majority of courses, all materials required for that course are provided (i.e. lectures, study guide, supplemental text). Courses that require additional materials will be clearly marked. Also included in the tuition are all testing and administrative fees.

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COURSE EXECUTION

Each MORIAH course consists of instructor lecture, a study guide, supplemental text/information, an open notes/book objective examination and optional resources on the world wide web. Each teaching segment is approximately 50 minutes in length. In general, three sessions constitute a one credit hour course, six sessions a two credit course, and nine sessions a three credit hour course. Students complete Moriah courses in two ways:

- 1. **Individually on the Online World Campus.** All course materials and resources are executed via the internet. Students are granted the legal right to download one copy of each item provided. The study guide, text and/or other supplemental information are provided in PDF (Adobe) format for downloading and printing. When appropriate, the Home Office will mail a hard copy of a text when it is unavailable in ebook or audio form. Students listen to the lectures while referencing the study guide, read the supplemental material and enter their examination answers in the online examination for immediate scoring.
- 2. In a group of five or more Moriah students. Five or more individual students in any location may function as a "Network Lecture Site" and execute courses together as a group. Depending on the group needs, course materials are accessed on the Online World Campus or may be mailed to the group. Course lectures are presented by video presentations and/or guest teachers. In a typical three hour credit course with nine hours of lecture, the usual schedule is three hours of class on Thursday evening, three hours on Friday evening and three hours on Saturday morning. This option is particularly attractive to pastors and local churches with a vision for onsite biblical higher education. In the event of a guest instructor, the lecture site is responsible for travel, lodging and meals expense. Consequently, a minimum of fifteen group students is required to host a guest instructor.
