

D.	Beryl: Hexagonal prisms, usually green or blue green. The emerald is a superior type of this stone. (It is on the Breast piece of Judgment - Ex. 28:20)
E.	Onyx: Milk white bands, alternating with black. (It is on the Breast piece of Judgment Ex. 28:20 39:13, 28:9, 39:6) Aaron's Ephod.
